

Processing Exceptions on EvoWeb – Doors

The following are some non-standard door processing pointers. (To process an enquiry from the beginning, see separate instruction sheet "To input an order or quote on EvoWeb").

- **Open In / Out:**

Single doors will automatically default to and 561510 Fitted Weather R as all Open In doors are fitted with weather rail. Care must be taken if you require the door to be Open Out. The program will not do this correctly. You must firstly change the response to the question to 561510 NOT Fitted Weat, then change the to as required.

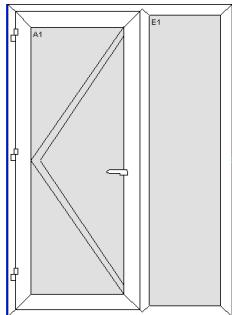
French Doors on the other hand will automatically default to , as this is the most popular requirement. The system will let you change to if necessary – you then need to remember to select as 561510 Fitted Weather R.

- **Doors with Aluminium Threshold:**

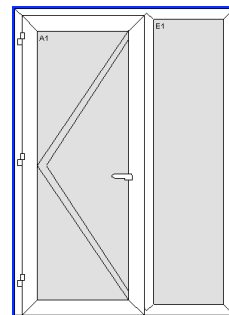
After you have selected the door style and input the frame dimensions, to make the door an aluminium threshold, click on the question - and select the appropriate response from the options listed:

You will see the frame at the bottom of the door sash disappears to indicate the aluminium threshold:

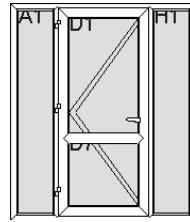
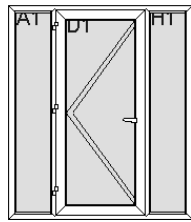

- **Adding midrail to doors:**

Any door design you select and click on the

APPLY MIDRAIL Button, the midrail will be added to the door sash only.

If you require midrails in the sidelights of a door, you will need to create the design (see separate instruction sheet "To input an order or quote on EvoWeb") and then apply midrail in the fashion outlined above. Care then must be taken as the transom duty will automatically default to

Transom 546475/65 82mm T/Z, whereas midrail duty is Midrail 546226 105mm M/R.

Therefore you must remember to match these up by re-selecting one to match the other, usually it will be re-selecting Transom duty to Transom 546226 105mm M/R.

- **Doors with Letterbox:**

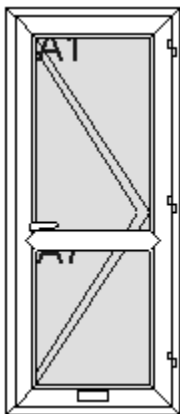
After you have selected the door style and input the frame dimensions, to add a letterbox to the midrail within the door, select the appropriate aperture in the Options section. This will be the top pane of the door, APERTURE : A1 in the example shown below.



The sash in the door will turn yellow on screen and the list of questions on the right-hand-side of the page will shorten to just those applying to the sash. Select from the

Letterbox question the type of letterbox you require by clicking on it.

- White
- Anodised Gold
- Black
- Satin
- Premium Gold



The letterbox will actually show in the bottom of the sash. Select the **NOTES** tab, and add a note as shown in the example below, clicking **OKAY** to save the note.



Complete the item as required, and continue with the order until finished.
